### Frameless Cabinets:

Sleek, clean look with full-coverage doors.

Offers a bit more accessibility than framed cabinets because there is no inside edge of a frame that's partially blocking.

The amount of storage space in frameless construction drawers/pull outs is greater than with framed cabinet construction because the drawer box is larger for a given cabinet size.

AFTER REFRACING: White Painted Maple Doors--Soapstone Countertops



**Chatoyancy** (in woodworking) is where certain finishes will cause the wood grain to achieve a striking three-dimensional appearance (changeable luster; twinkling). This effect is sometimes referred to as a "wet look." Oil finishes and shellac can bring out the effect strongly.

**Stainless Steel Sink Tips:**  
**DON'T** rub cleaning products against the grain of the finish  
**DO** keep your sink dry
